## SIDEWALK, DRIVEWAY, PATIO, AND OTHER EXTERIOR CONCRETE SPECIFICATIONS

The City of Ludlow guidelines for sidewalks require that all sidewalks be a minimum of 4 inches in thickness and driveway aprons be 6 inches. The balance of the driveway must be a minimum of 4 inches.

The Kentucky Building Code requires that exterior flatwork be a minimum 3,500 p.s.i. and be air-entrained. All weather types of pours must meet minimum standards.

The City of Ludlow requires cold weather protection for any concrete poured when temperatures are 28° or below.

Excavations must be level and free of loose debris. If the ground is loose, it must be compacted. Frames shall be clean and straight. All concrete materials, forms, fillers, and the ground shall be free from frost.

Concrete (other than high-early-strength) shall be maintained above 50° F, and in a moist condition for at least the first three days after placement, unless accelerated curing methods are used as prescribed in ACI 318.

Control, expansion, and construction joints shall be used per the requirements in the KBC. Expansion joints must be placed between old work and new work.

The entire excavation shall be protected in a manner to alert the public that a danger exists.

THE BUILDING INSPECTOR MUST BE NOTIFIED <u>BEFORE</u> THE CONCRETE IS PLACED. ANY CONCRETE THAT HAS NOT HAD AN EXCAVATION INSPECTION WILL NOT BE APPROVED.

A SECOND INSPECTION IS REQUIRED AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE JOB.
